Scholarships Now Open

The Huntsville AFWA Chapter is now accepting scholarship applications. Each scholarship will not exceed \$500.

Scholarships are limited to persons attending accredited colleges, universities, or professional schools of accounting in the state of Alabama who are pursuing a bachelors or masters degree in accounting and/or finance.

Applicants must be part-time or full-time students who have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours or 90 quarter hours with a declared major in accounting.

The scholarship committee or their designated representatives may choose to conduct personal interviews with the applicants.

Applicants must obtain a transcript from the registrar of the school showing grades and courses taken. The transcript is to be submitted with the application.

The applicant's need for financial assistance will be a primary determining factor. Scholarship recipients will receive a letter notifying them of their selection, and they will be honored at the chapter's Student Night in April.

The deadline for submitting applications for the 2014-2015 academic year is February 15, 2015.

Scholarship awards will be sent upon notification from the school that the student has enrolled and fees are due. The check will be payable to the school to apply against the amount due from the student.

Now Accepting Applications

The Foundation of AFWA is now accepting applications for scholarships for various levels of education, including undergraduate through PhD, as well as review course and certification exams.

Scholarships are open to members and the public and are due on April 1, 2015.

The scholarships open for accounting and finance students are:

- Undergraduate Scholarship: To support the costs of attending 3rd, 4th, or 5th year when pursuing an accounting or finance degree
- Masters Scholarship: For those attending an accredited College or University enrolled in a master's program, and is pursuing an accounting or finance degree.
- Native American Scholarship: To support the costs of attending 3rd, 4th, or 5th year when pursuing an accounting or finance degree. Applicant must be enrolled or a direct descendant of an enrolled member in a Federal or State recognized tribe.

Only for AFWA members:

- Certification: To support the exam fees of AFWA members for any of the following certifications: CPA, CFP, CFE, CIA, CMA, or CVA.
- CPAexcel Review: To provide registration for a CPAexcel CPA Review Course
- PhD Scholarship: To cover cost of research for a PhD student.
